INTRODUCTION

Over 80 young players, 18 coaches, 6 clubs from 6 European countries, and a 30-member organizing team came together to celebrate 72 hours of football, diversity, and solidarity at the Girls Football Festival held in Vienna from June 28th to 30th, 2024. They came together for fun-packed get-to-know-each-other evening in Prater, completed 8 workshops and training stations, explored the city of Vienna through a playful scavenger hunt, enjoyed empanadas, pizzas, and much more. They also competed in an international football tournament in mixed teams, learning to work together across borders. Most importantly, they formed countless new friendships and got to know players from other countries. These three unforgettable days spent in Vienna created memories that will last a lifetime - all of which was the Girls Football Festival 2024!

The Girls Football Festival was co-funded by the European Union through the "Sport Zajedno" project and the UEFA through the "Football Zajedno" project, together with the football associations from Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro, as well as the Austrian Development Agency (ADA), the City of Vienna's "Bewegung findet Stadt," and the BMKÖS.



GIRLS FOOTBALL FESTIVAL

From June 28th to 30th 2024, the sixth edition of the international Girls football Festival took place in Vienna. As a collaborative project from Sport Zajedno, Football Zajedno and VIDC – fairplay Initiative, 8 teams from 6 countries – including Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, Montenegro, Serbia, and Austria, were invited to participate in a 3-day international football exchange.

The idea

The goal of the Girls Football Festival (GFF) is to facilitate international exchange, explore different training methods, and share the joy of football together. The organisers are committed to promoting unity instead of exclusion through the festival, as well as highlighting the diversity and inclusivity of the teams and players. The aim is to address nationalism and discrimination across national borders and empower and elevate girls and women through football.

A new introduction to the 2024 edition was the use of mixed teams: on the second day of the festival, the players were organised into new teams, with representatives from each country. Organisers ensured all players could communicate with the presence of English, BCMS, and German speakers. The goal of mixing the teams was the further the inclusion aim of the GFF.

As seen in the [evaluation report](#), the idea to mix the players into new teams for their activities in Vienna was a great success. The players reported that their initial feelings of shyness disappeared, the festival gave them the chance to learn from each other, for example with the exchange of traditional dances and songs that took place on Saturday evening. On the final day, the tournament was played between new friends, not strangers from across a border.

GIRLS FOOTBALL FESTIVAL

fairplay - Association for Diversity in Sports

The fairplay initiative was launched at the Vienna Institute for International Dialogue and Cooperation (VIDC) in 1997 during the European Year against Racism. It has since evolved into a recognised nationwide initiative in Austria, dedicated to combating racism and all forms of discrimination in football and sports. Working together with fans, players, clubs, and associations, fairplay aims to harness the integrative power of football to fight against all forms of discrimination in sports at various levels.

Efforts against discrimination in sports, promoting the social inclusion of migrants through sports, educational work with young people, as well as girls' and women's football and human rights in the context of major sporting events, have emerged as important areas of focus over the years.

Project „Sport Zajedno“

The "Sport Zajedno" project aims to promote social inclusion and post-conflict reconciliation among young people in and through grassroots sport across the Western Balkans. Methods to achieve this objective include training, education, awareness-raising, capacity-building of local grassroots sport stakeholders and youth sport interventions. The project brings together civil society organisations and sport clubs from Austria, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Croatia, Kosovo, Montenegro and Serbia.

Project „Football Zajedno“

The Football Zajedno project aims to promote mutual appreciation, fairplay, respect, and teamwork through football while combating nationalism and racism in the Western Balkans. This is achieved through educational projects and youth exchanges. The Girls Football Festival is part of the Football Zajedno project, which is supported by UEFA and implemented in cooperation with the football associations of Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro, as well as local partner organisations in the Western Balkans. The project is coordinated by fairplay.

Focus on Sustainability

As part of the Rebels of Change (RoC) project, which aims to make sport more sustainable, inclusive, and accessible, efforts were made to make the festival more environmentally sustainable. The main focus was on recycling, reusing, and reducing plastic waste, but we were faced with various challenges along the way.

Collaboration Partners

GFF 2024 was funded by national and international sponsors and carried out in collaboration with several partners. The organisational planning and implementation were led by the fairplay initiative at VIDC. Sport Zajedno and the sports initiative iZi (Igramo Zajedno Inicijativa) from Bosnia and Herzegovina were the main partners from the Western Balkans. Additionally, there was collaboration with the aforementioned partners from the Football Zajedno project.

The fairplay organising team, consisting of David Hudelist and Max Bombarde, together with Benjamin Dragolj and Selma Memović from the iZi organization, was responsible for developing the concept of the Girls Football Festival. The organising team designed the sports and educational framework for the girls' tournament. The practical implementation on such a large scale was made possible by a dedicated team of fairplay workshop leaders and volunteers, as well as Sport Zajedno and Football Zajedno multipliers.

Funding organisations & sponsors

The 2024 edition of the Girls Football Festival benefited from funding from the European Union through the Sport Zajedno project, and the Union of European Football Association (UEFA) as part of the Football Zajedno project. National football associations from Bosnia-Herzegovina and Montenegro, the Austrian Development Agency (ADA), as well as the City of Vienna “Bewegung findet Stadt”, and the Austria Ministry of the Arts, Culture, the Civil Service and Sport (Bundesministerium für Kunst, Kultur, öffentlichen Dienst und Sport - BMKÖS) also played significant roles in supporting the GFF 2024. These contributions helped make the GFF 2024 possible and contributed to its success.

Teams

A total of 8 clubs participated in the 6th Girls Football Festival in Vienna. All nations except from Bosnia and Herzegovina were represented by one team, Bosnia and Herzegovina was able to send three teams to the GFF 2024. In the selection process of the participating teams, the organisers paid special attention to including clubs from both structured sports organisations and the informal sector, such as socio-pedagogical projects. This approach aimed to present a diverse approach to football and provide a varied access to the sport. The primary focus of the festival was to have a great time together, get to know each other, and break down prejudices.



GIRLS FOOTBALL FESTIVAL

FIRST VIENNA FC 1894 (AUSTRIA)



First Vienna FC was established in 1894 and was the first Bundesliga football team in Austria to start a Women's league, in 1989. After its dissolution in 1997, the women's section was revived in 2011. Currently, the club has a team in the Planet Pure Frauen-Bundesliga, a team in the Future League, and four youth teams with around 70 girls aged between 7 and 16 years old.

KFV PRISHTINA (KOSOVO)



KFV Prishtina was established in 2019 and it is the first multiethnic women football team in Kosovo offering free football coaching session to over 400 girls in different municipalities in Kosovo. Last year we established first women team with Down syndrome offering them free football coaching session. KFV Prishtina has grown from a modest football club into a prominent symbol of athletic excellence and social progress.

Our journey began with a group of passionate football enthusiasts committed to creating a space where talent could thrive regardless of background. From our early days, we have focused on inclusivity and community engagement, prevention of Gender Based Violence, laying a strong foundation for our later commitments to gender equality and human rights.

Our ethos is built on providing equal opportunities and fostering an inclusive environment for all players, regardless of gender, ethnicity or religion.

NK INTER POSUŠJE (BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA)



The women's football club Inter is based in Posušje. It was founded in mid-2017 and currently has over 50 members. We compete in the First Women's League of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

NK SLOGA GORNJI VAKUF – USKOPLJE (BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA)



The Women's Football Club Sloga was founded in 2017 in Gornji Vakuf Uskoplje. ŽNK "Sloga" brings together girls from the Gornji Vakuf-Uskoplje area with the aim of promoting women's football, socializing, competing, and having fun. Our club gathers girls from the entire municipality of Gornji Vakuf Uskoplje, and as of this year, we have girls from other cities who come to train with us, which we are very proud of.

Through various activities and projects, both domestic and international, the club continuously grows and attracts an increasing number of young people who actively participate in the club's work. Over the years of our existence, we have developed many friendships across Bosnia and Herzegovina by participating in various tournaments and competitions.

The pinnacle of our club's hard work came this year when we participated for the first time in the First League of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina for women. This year, we managed to secure financial resources and organize everything necessary for such a competition.

Additionally, one of our greatest achievements is the invitation to the Girls Football Festival in Vienna, where we hope to represent our town and country in the best possible way and to establish various friendships and new acquaintances with whom we can cooperate in the future.

ŽFK BORAC BIJELO POLJE (MONTENEGRO)



The Women's Football Club Borac was established in 2022 in Bijelo Polje, Montenegro. The club currently comprises 30 girls, with whom three coaches, all possessing UEFA licenses, work diligently. The primary aim of founding the club is to promote and develop women's football in our city and the broader region of Northern Montenegro. The focus lies on nurturing younger age categories. By participating in local, regional, and national competitions, the girls gain invaluable experiences, promote fair play, a healthy lifestyle, and teamwork, all while proudly representing Montenegro.

ŽFK LEOTAR TREBINJE (BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA)



We were established on August 13, 2022. Currently, we have 70 girls in our club. We proudly hold the title of champions in the first league of Republika Srpska for women and have secured a spot in the Premier League of Bosnia and Herzegovina for women. Additionally, we achieved the runner-up position in the U13 girls' league of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Our coaching staff comprises licensed professionals dedicated to our players' development. Jelena Milović leads as the head coach of our senior team and serves as the U19 national team selector for Bosnia and Herzegovina. Anja Stević oversees our youth selections and contributes as an assistant coach for the U17 national team of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

ŽFSU MERAKI NIŠ (SERBIA)



ŽFSU 'Meraki' was established at the end of last year. We officially commenced operations on March 18, 2024, with girls aged 7 to 12 years old. Currently, we are not competing, but we plan to start participating in the Fair Play League in Niš from September onwards.

ŽNK LEGEN (CROATIA)



ŽNK Legen is a women's football club based in Slavonski Brod, Croatia. The club was founded with the aim of promoting women's football and providing opportunities for girls and women to engage in the sport at a competitive level. ŽNK Legen competes in domestic leagues and cups, contributing to the development of women's football in the region through its activities and programs.

The programme

The Girls Football Festival is not a conventional football tournament! The festival stands out primarily for its diverse program, which includes workshops, training sessions, playful stations incorporating cultural elements, and aims to break down stereotypes and prejudices. The focus is on empowering girls, promoting respect and fair play, and fostering new friendships and acquaintances.

Friday 28th of June 2024

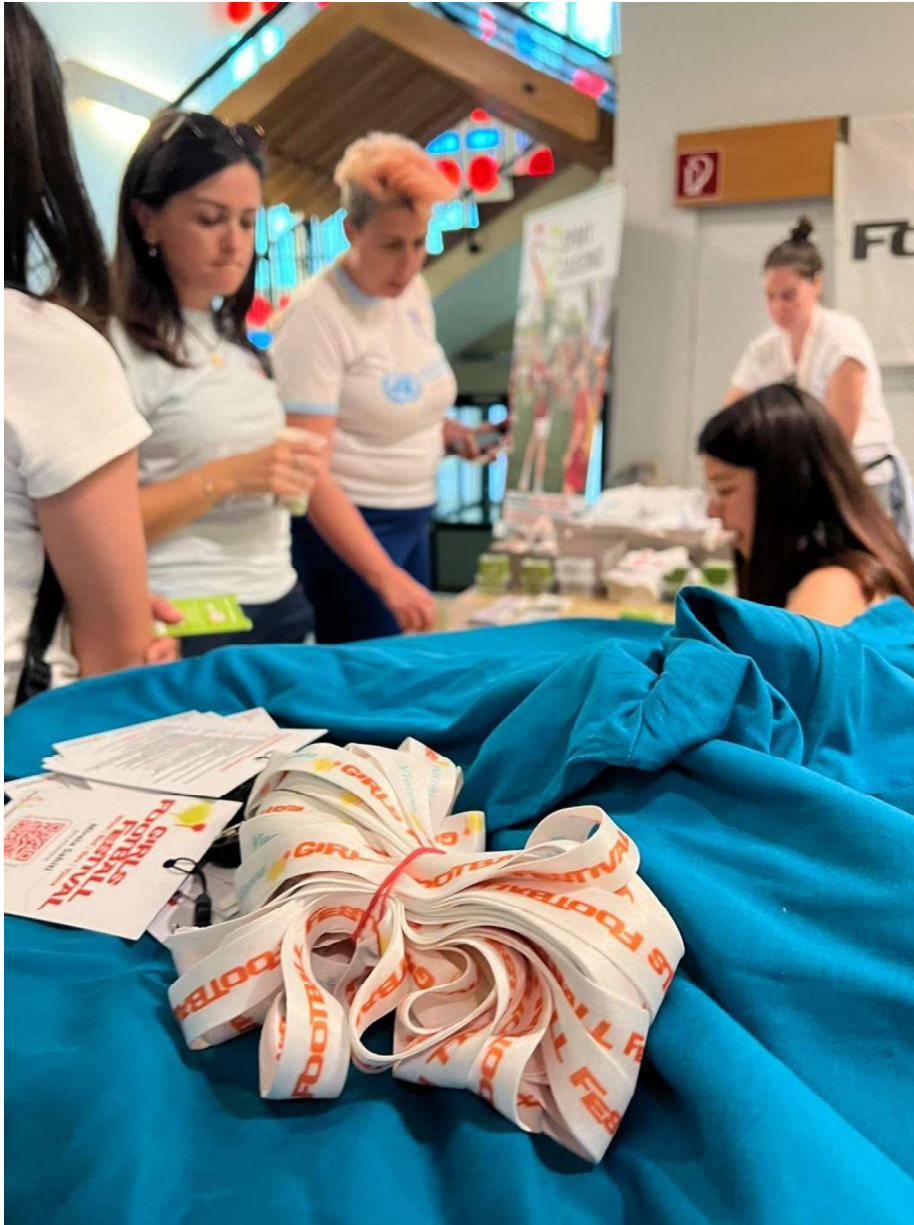

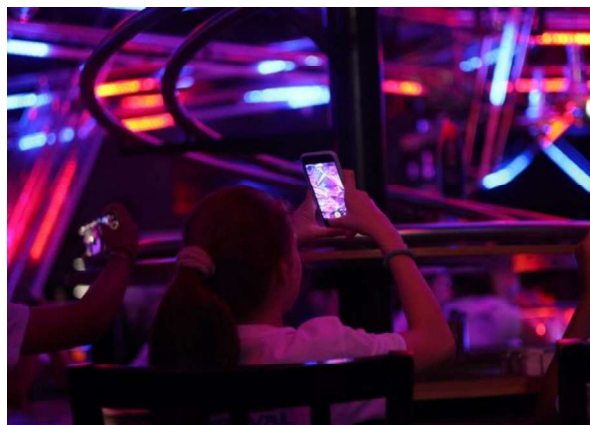

It was a successful day full of adventures and new experiences. Finally, we returned to the youth hostel tired but happy, to rest and prepare for the next day.

Saturday 29th of June 2024

Saturday was dedicated to the theme of "Zajedno" (together) - both on and off the field, the girls and coaches spent time together in newly mixed groups, providing them with the opportunity to get to know each other better. After breakfast at the hotel, the players were organised into their new teams and embarked on an exciting scavenger hunt through Vienna. Austrian players were given the additional opportunity to showcase "their" city. Each international team was accompanied by a supervisor who had knowledge of BCS (Bosnian, Croatian, Serbian) and English, providing support during the scavenger hunt.

To ensure that all groups didn't follow the same path through Vienna, each group was assigned a different starting point. They were then able to decide the order in which they visited the four designated stations and tackled the quiz questions and/or group activities. The stations included Karlsplatz, Stephansplatz, and Schwedenplatz.

After the groups had their adventurous experiences, they had to present their "proof" photos and answer questions from the festival organisers. It was an entertaining and interactive way for the players to get to know each other and Vienna.

After a hearty lunch provided within Vienna's Werkstätten- und Kulturhaus, the players enjoyed a few hours of free time to rest, explore the city, and get ready for the training in the afternoon.

The training and workshop session took place on the First Vienna Football Campus, on Spielmannsgasse the 20th district, just a short walk from the hotel.

Our organisers had been on the spot early, preparing and marking the entire stadium. After a warm welcome, the mixed teams were sent to the 8 different training stations to facilitate cross-team interaction and bonding. Each training station was supervised by a tandem of trainers and multipliers, paired together to broach the language barriers.

The training stations provided sessions on football skills, workshops on inclusion, and space for thinking about gender equality in sport. The stations included a Streetkick zone, a fairplay introductory workshop, a games corner, a dribbling and shooting skills workshop, tournament preparation, a microsoccer, a discussion zone on equality, a passing and coordination workshop, an inclusion activity, and a rest and refreshments zone. The players, who had started getting to know their new teams in the morning, spent the afternoon of training learning from each other from listening to other experiences to new football skills.

The trainers at the stations were impressed by the dedication and motivation of all the players and the sense of community among them. The trainers themselves benefited from mutual exchange, acquiring new training methods and tips from their colleagues.

Sunday 30th of June 2024

On the third and final day of the festival, the 6th international Girls Football Festival football tournament took place at the Football Campus of First Vienna FC. The GFF tournament started at 9:30 AM with a collective kick-off, where all participants were briefed on the rules, format, and, most importantly, the values of respect and fairplay.

Organisers also took this opportunity to ask about team names: all teams were given the possibility to name themselves after being mixed. Every single team had chosen a new name over the course of the previous day, demonstrating a real bond had formed between these players. Some teams even included name specific warm ups: the “Fisherwomen” warmed up by playing fishes on the ground being reeled in by their coaches, as seen in the photo below.



The tournament officially started with the first matches at 10:00 AM. This year, we organised the tournament in a championship format, where each team played against every other team. A total of eight teams participated, where players demonstrated high-levels of teamwork and football knowledge.

The matches were played simultaneously on two fields, with 7+1 players on each half of the field, and each match lasted for 10 minutes without a break.

Our referees faced particular challenges, not due to unfair play or disputes, but rather due to the scorching heat that imposed significant physical strain.

In order to provide our referees with some rest time, three referees were requested for this tournament. The referees were all certified by the Austrian Football Association and were respected by the players and coaches. The tournament was characterised by intense performances, high quality, mutual respect, and fairplay. Despite the challenging circumstances delivered by high heat and multiple languages on the pitch, our referees handled their responsibilities with great skill and contributed to ensuring fair and equitable matches.

EN PLAYING FOOTBALL TOGETHER AND BREAKING DOWN PREJUDICES

From June 28-30, 2024, the Girls Football Festival will take place in Vienna for the sixth time. Youth girls' teams from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Croatia, Montenegro, Serbia, and Austria will meet in Vienna for sports and intercultural exchange. They will train together, play games, explore the city, and address topics such as **sexism, identity, respect, and fair play** as part of the program.

The goal is to **empower girls, promote diversity** instead of exclusion, and thus work across national borders **against nationalism and discrimination**. Girls and women should gain more visibility through the Girls Football Festival.

“For me, football is everything – a way to learn, grow, and make friends. I feel super powerful when I play football. In Vienna I managed to find friends even though I do not know English, and sometimes in my country, people do not want to be friends with me because I am Roma. 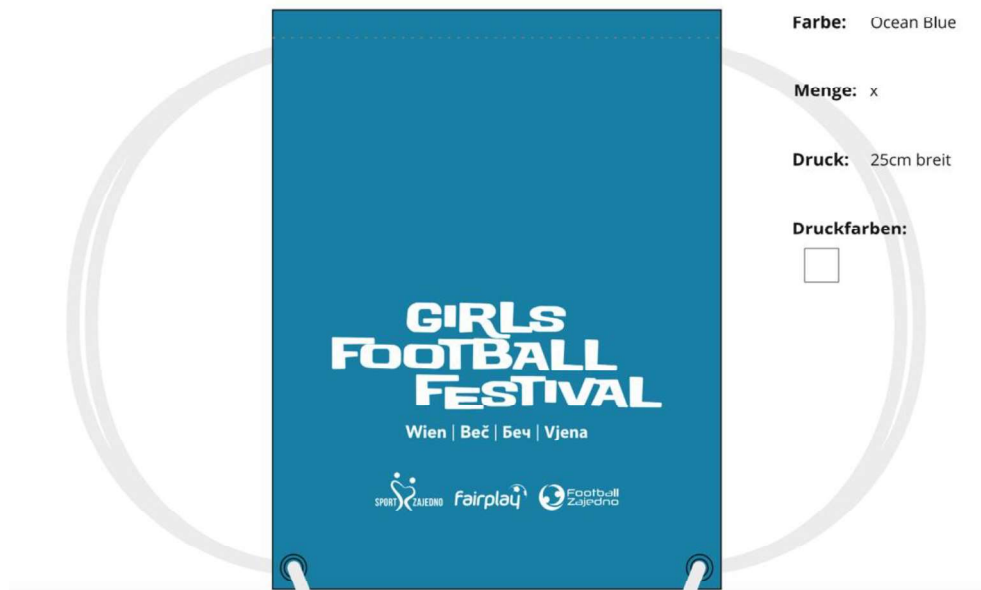

IDEA

Cilj Girls Football Festivala (GFF) je olakšati međunarodnu razmjenu, istražiti različite metode treniranja i podijeliti radost fudbala zajedno. Organizatori su posvećeni promoviranju jedinstva umjesto isključivanja kroz festival, kao i isticanju raznolikosti i inkluzivnosti timova i igračica. Cilj je suočiti se s nacionalizmom i diskriminacijom preko nacionalnih granica te osnažiti i unaprijediti djevojčice i žene kroz fudbal.

Nova uvodna novina za izdanje 2024. godine bila je upotreba mješovitih timova: drugog dana festivala, igračice su bile organizovane u nove timove, s predstavnicama iz svake zemlje. Organizatori su osigurali da sve igračice mogu komunicirati uz prisustvo govornika engleskog, BCMS-a i njemačkog jezika. Cilj miješanja timova bio je dodatno jačanje inkluzivne misije GFF-a.

Kako je prikazano u evaluacijskom izvještaju, ideja miješanja igračica u nove timove za njihove aktivnosti u Beču bila je veliki uspjeh. Igračice su izvijestile da su njihovi početni osjećaji stidljivosti nestali, a festival im je pružio priliku da uče jedna od druge, na primjer kroz razmjenu tradicionalnih plesova i pjesama koja se dogodila u subotu navečer. fairplay - Udruženje za različitost u sportu

Inicijativa fairplay pokrenuta je u Bečkom institutu za međunarodni dijalog i suradnju (VIDC) 1997. godine tokom Evropske godine borbe protiv rasizma. Od tada se razvila u prepoznatljivu nacionalnu inicijativu u Austriji, posvećenu borbi protiv rasizma i svih oblika diskriminacije u fudbalu i sportu. Saradnjom s navijačima, igračima, klubovima i udruženjima, fairplay ima za cilj iskoristiti integrativnu moć fudbala u borbi protiv svih oblika diskriminacije u sportu na različitim nivoima.

Napori u borbi protiv diskriminacije u sportu, promociji socijalne inkluzije migranata kroz sport, edukativni rad s mladima, kao i ženski fudbal i ljudska prava u kontekstu velikih sportskih događaja, postali su važni fokusi tokom godina.

Projekt "Sport Zajedno"

Projekt "Sport Zajedno" ima za cilj promovisanje socijalne inkluzije i postkonfliktnog pomirenja među mladima kroz amaterski sport širom Zapadnog Balkana. Metode za postizanje ovog cilja uključuju obuku, edukaciju, podizanje svijesti, jačanje kapaciteta lokalnih dionika amaterskog sporta i intervencije u sportu za mlade. Projekt okuplja organizacije civilnog društva i sportske klubove iz Austrije, Bosne i Hercegovine, Hrvatske, Kosova, Crne Gore i Srbije.

Projekt "Football Zajedno"

Projekt Football Zajedno ima za cilj promovisanje međusobnog uvažavanja, fairplaya, poštovanja i timskog rada kroz fudbal, dok se bori protiv nacionalizma i rasizma na Zapadnom Balkanu. Ovo se postiže kroz edukativne projekte i omladinske razmjene. Girls Football Festival je dio projekta Football Zajedno, koji podržava UEFA i provodi se u saradnji s fudbalskim savezima Bosne i Hercegovine i Crne Gore, kao i lokalnim partnerskim organizacijama na Zapadnom Balkanu. Projekt koordinira fairplay.

Fokus na održivost

Kao dio projekta Rebels of Change (RoC), koji ima za cilj učiniti sport održivijim, inkluzivnijim i pristupačnijim, poduzeti su napori da se festival učini ekološki održivim. 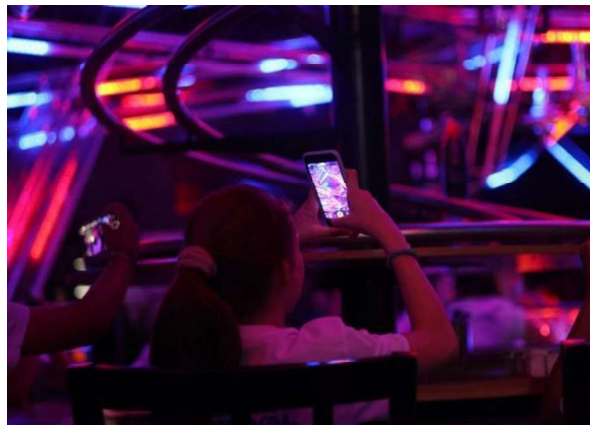

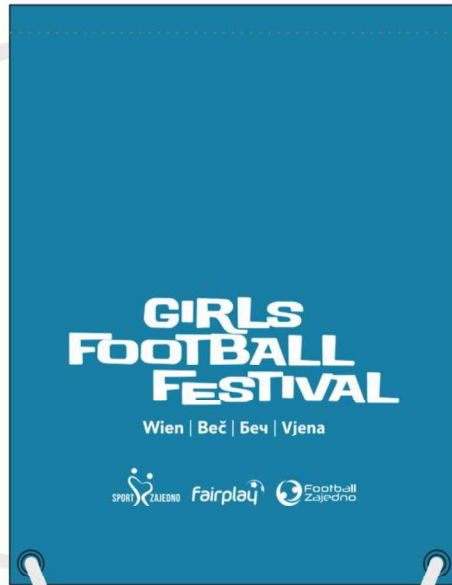
